Tulane shuts out LSU in Alex Box, win 1-0 . (Tuesday, 4/6/2004)

In a thrilling pitcher's duel, Brian Bogusevic came out on top, as he and Joey Charron combined to pitch a 4 hit shutout against LSU in Baton Rouge on Wednesday. It marked the first time since 1968 that Tulane had shutout LSU. Brian claimed his 5th win on the season, and Joey Charron tied the Tulane career save record with 27.

The Wave had just enough offense, as Nathan Southard led off the 6th inning with a double, and 2 batters later, Matt Barket drove in the winning, and only run, with a single.

The Tulane – Louisiana St. series is now tied 1-1 on the season, and will finish up with a game on April 27, in the Superdome.

Wave out-hits Cards 12-10, but loses the game 5-2. (Friday, 4/9/2004)



Billy Mohl – 7.1 ip, 4 runs, 5 K's

Billy Mohl held the Cardinals to 1 first inning run during the first 6 innings, but that wasn't enough as Tulane could only score 1 run in the same stretch. In the final 3 innings, the Cardinals were able score 4 runs, while the Wave could score only 1. Daniel Latham had another solid outing giving up 1 un-earned run in 1.2 innings of relief.

The Wave out-hit the Cardinals 12-10, and multiple hit batters included Matt Barket, Brian Bormaster, and Wes Swackhammer, all going 2-4 on the night.

Wave bats come alive with 36 hits in Saturday doubleheader. Tulane defeats the Cardinals, and win the series 2-1, on scores of 13-1 and 10-3. Wave gets 2 great pitching performances by Crowel and Hahn.
